Auctioneers Gwilym Richards & Co were greeted with a kaleidoscope of colour and spirited bidding from a packed ringside with all cattle finding new homes.

The sale started with the freshly calved milkers with the first animal in the ring, a Holstein Friesian heifer from Jack Watts and his father Gareth of Bedwas making 2,000 guineas.

The top priced calved Holstein Friesian calved heifer at 2,120gns was sold by Brownwood Holsteins, Worcester, with another from the same home making 2,050gns.

The sale included a consignment of Montbeliarde calved heifers from Edvin Farms, Worcestershire, selling to 1,600 guineas twice both being purchased by a Somerset buyer.

Jersey calved heifers from Beechdean Farms, Buckinghamshire, sold to 1,120gns, one of a lorry load of 10 going to a Pembrokeshire farm.

Holstein Friesian in-calf heifers from T H Davis & Son, Gloucester, sold to 1,500gns, with Irish in-calf heifers selling to 1,350gns.

Bulling heifers from Mrs A Vaughan, Herefordshire, met a flying trade selling to 900gns.
