

NON RECORDED HOLSTEIN FRIESIANS TO 1,450GNS AT CARDIFF

1,450gns was achieved on two occasions when the pedigree Llanishen herd of non-recorded Holstein Friesians was dispersed on the edge of the city of Cardiff for John Phillips and his son Jonathan.

Both 1,450gns bids were made by Chepstow buyers W T R & J A Parry for the Criche Principal sired 2nd calver Clerkenwell Principal Bracken and the Zidane sired 2nd calver Llanishen Zidance Holly.

Messrs Parry also paid 1,420gns for another 2nd calver sired by Zidane, Llanishen Zidane Trix.

Ketby Babs 30th, a daughter of Comestar Lee, made 1,420gns to D C & L A Cullimore, Berkeley, Gloucestershire. She was bred from 4 generations of Very Good and Excellent cows.

A 3rd calver by Etazon Lord Lily, Llanishen Lord Lily Belle, sold for 1,380gns to Messrs Parry.

A R Edwards & Son of Newport paid 1,350gns for Llanishen Zidane Kelly, a 3rd calver sired by Zidane.

The non-pedigree 5 year old Simmental stock bull sold for 1,520gns to W C & M E George & Son, Hereford.

All the cattle were in-calf to the Simmental bull and there was only one Holstein Friesian maiden heifer in the sale.

35 four figures prices were recorded with buyers in attendance from throughout South and West Wales as well as Cornwall, Somerset and Wiltshire.
