The recently launched Mid-Month Sales incorporating the Monthly Show & Sale of Fresh Milkers and the Collective Sale of Youngstock of All Ages attracted sellers and buyers from throughout England and Wales.

The Show was ably judged by regular supporter Richard Bowdler of Ellesmere, Shropshire, and awarded the 1st prize rosette to RJ Rose & Partners of Chinnor, Oxfordshire, which then sold for the day's highest price of £2,400 to Henry Elkin of Stone, Staffordshire.
