BEST 12 AVERAGE £1,800 TO A TOP OF £2,000

No flash points but another consistent level trade although trade was generally easier reflecting in part the general lower standard of the cattle forward.

The best still sold well to a top of £2,000 for the first heifer in the ring from L.F. Horton & Sons, Northwich.

Other heifers making over £1,800 included £1,950 from E.V. & B. Boughey & Son, Iddenshall, £1,900 from D. & E. Monk, Ormskirk, £1,820 E.V. & B. Boughey & Son, Iddenshall and £1,800 Lloyd Thomas, Carmarthenshire.

The top priced cow was £1,800 for a third calver from D. & E. Monk, Ormskirk.

Milky cows sold really well and were in good demand with second calvers at £1,780 from J. & M. Sanderson, Lancashire and £1,700 M.W. & J.M. Trevor-Jones, Middleton.
