**£2,380 TOP HEIFER - £2,350 COW TOP
TOP TEN HEIFERS AVERAGE £2,230 - ALL SOLD**

The Drayton dairy trade continues on its upward spiral. When will it stop? There was another total clearance with new buyers in attendance.

Top price was £2380 for a calved heifer from Betley Court Farm Partnership, Crewe, closely followed by the top price for a cow of £2350 for a second calver from Malcolm Trevor Jones, Oswestry, who sold another second calver for £2200 and a third calver for £2000. Freeford Farms, Lichfield sold a second calver for £2050.

Second best price for a heifer was £2270 from O.C Whittaker & Sons, Tabley. AA Winstanley & Partners, Audlem sold to £2250, £2150 and £2050 averaging £2083 for their four. Rhys Jones, Kidwelly sold to £2220, Geoff Williams, Hay on Wye £2200, David Monk, Orsmkirk £2200 and £2020, John Rees, Brecon £2080, Mark Boughey, Iddenshall £2060 & £2000.

There were 16 cattle over £2000 (12 heifers & 4 cows), 3 heifers over £1900 and 4 over £1800 (3 heifers and a cow)

A consignment of 18 commercial in calf heifers calving to an Angus from August to October from Wyn Morgan, Newcastle Emlyn sold to £1750 with seven at £1700. All 18 averaged £1551.

An eleven-day old heifer calf sold for £380.
