A FLYING TRADE – TOTAL CLEARANCE COWS £2,300 TWICE – HEIFERS £2,200

What the cattle lacked in quality today was more than made up with a very dear trade from another full ringside including a number of new buyers when many more could have been quickly sold.

Cows were in great demand again selling to £2,300 on two occasions for second calvers from John Hill, Leicestershire with third calvers to £1,900 and fourth calvers to £1,880 also from the same home.

Phillip Adams, Butterton sold second calvers to £2,000 and £1,920 and third calvers to £1,950. John Lomax, Baldwins Gate sold second calvers to £2,180 and £2,050.

The best 10 cows averaged £2,058.

Heifers sold to a top of £2,200 from Steve Hill, Tamworth with another of his heifers selling for £1,980. RW & EE Edwards, Whitchurch sold their heifers at £2,120 and £2,000. Dafydd Jones, Corwen to £1,940 and Andrew Ball, Sandbach to £1,900.

The best 5 heifers averaged £2,048.

Out wintered grazing cross-bred calved heifers sold from £880 to £1,000.

A Hereford stock bull (39 months) sold for £1,540.
