£3,050 RECORD PRICE FOR DAIRY COW AND NEW £3,020 HEIFER RECORD

Dairy records were made and broken today at Drayton with David Monk of Ormskirk, Lancashire, selling his second calver Bannistree Pex Vera 133 for £3,050, the record price for a cow at the weekly auction. David also broke the record price for a heifer making £3,020 of Bannistree Primrose 200 beating his own record of £3,000 set nine weeks ago.

The trade was very strong for the very best with David's other heifer selling for £2,720.

Robert and Judith Faulkner, Oswestry sold heifers at £2,520, £2,350, £2,300, £2,000 and £1,980 with their 12 heifers averaging £1,928.

Steve and Rob Bailey, Crewe, sold their Ayrshire heifers to £2,220 with others at £2,050 and £1,980.

Other heifers sold at £2,120 and £1,980 for Andrew Ball, Sandbach.

The top 10 dairies averaged £2,435 but the trade for the second quality was a lot easier and the third quality very difficult.

Second quality heifers ranged from £1,600 to £1,880 and second quality cows sold to £1,700.

In-calf cows sold to £1,680. Crossbred heifer calves to £80.
