

ROSS HOLSTEIN FRIESIANS TO 1,850GNS THREE TIMES

There was standing room only around the packed ringside at Ross-on-Wye Market, Herefordshire, for the June Collective Sale of Holstein Friesians.

The first to achieve the top price of 1,850gns was Tretire Westminster Royal Lady, a freshly calved heifer from Idris and Mark Evans of St Owens Cross, Hereford. She was sired by Avenham Westminster and out of a Genus Jayson dam. She was purchased by S C Vaughan of Leominster, Herefordshire.

The next at 1,850gns was a freshly calved commercial heifer from J Morgan, Tewkesbury. The buyers were S & C May, Bromsgrove, Worcestershire.

The other 1,850gns was the leading price in the dispersal sale of the Shucknall herd for C R Bayliss & Sons, Weston Beggard, Hereford. Shucknall Aaron Pearce was a 2nd calver by Dixie Lee Aaron out of Trevasse Lily Pearce by Etazon Lord Lily. She was giving 51kgs daily and was bought by H E & J A Cowles & Son, Lydart, Monmouth.

Top price in the dispersal sale of Peter Cuthbert's commercial herd from Minsterworth, Gloucester, was 1650gns for a March calved 2nd calver by Avenham Westminster. The buyer was D A Bennion of Shrewsbury, Shropshire.

Served heifers sold to 1,550gns for Hasworth Baxter Tiffany 56th, a Emerald ACR Sat Baxter daughter off a 10,258kg Hershel dam from B Rich, Gloucester. The buyers were the Mollatt Partnership of Uttoxeter, Staffordshire.

Heifer calves sold to 980gns.

A 4 year old Aberdeen Angus stock bull sold for 1,620gns.
