£2,900 THREE TIMES - £3,500 BRITISH BLUE BULL

The August Show and Sale sponsored by Gro-Agri was very well attended when many more cattle could have been sold to take advantage of the very strong and consistent trade.

The choice of the judge Kelly Hill as the Champion of the Western Holstein Club supported monthly event was one of three heifers sharing the day's top price of £2,900.

The Champion was the pedigree heifer Lachstone Butch S Goldilock from Jeremy Platt of Lachstone Farms, Northwich. Another heifer from the same home sold for £2,900 with all nine of their heifers averaging £2,456.

The first prize non pedigree heifer from Kingarth, Leicester also made £2,900.

Other leading prices for heifers were Ray Brown & Partners, Holmes Chapel £2,700 and £2,500, Lachstone Farms £2,450 twice and £2,400, Kingarth £2,400, DP Bourne, Nantwich £2,400, HS & A Callwood, Knutsford £2,400.

The pedigree third calver Heathleigh Aladdin Liberty Red from L Horton & Sons, Northwich topped the cow section selling at £2,520.

The first prize commercial cow was a second calver from NK & CL Jackson, Whitchurch which made £2,500.

Third calvers from Kingarth sold for £2,450 and L Horton & Sons £2,350 twice.
