RECORD ENTRY – £3,000 TWICE – 48 OVER £2,000

The September Show and Sale sponsored by Bidlea Bulls attracted a record entry of 162 dairies with cattle selling to £3,000.

Judging the monthly fixture supported by the Western Holstein Club was Graham Warner. Graham chose as his Champion the first prize pedigree heifer Brill Sumerian Dellia from John Rees, Brecon, which later sold for £3,000.

Lachstone Farms, Northwich averaged £2,601 for 7 heifers with their best to £2,820, £2,800, £2,780, £2,600 and £2,450.

W. Herdman & Sons, Cambridgeshire sold heifers to £2,700, Wyndford Wagyu, Newport £2,500, AF & R Stannage, Leicester £2,500, GJ Sutton, Congleton £2,500 and £2,400, Brindley Family, Adderley £2,500 and £2,400, OC Whittaker & Sons, Knutsford £2,450 (first prize non-pedigree heifer), LF Horton & Sons, Northwich £2,450, Clayden Farm Partners, Crewe £2,420 twice, Hankins Heys Farm, Nantwich £2,400.

Cows sold to £2,720 for the first prize commercial cow, a non-pedigree third calver from the Brindley Family.

Four pedigree cows from Clayden Farm Partners, Crewe, averaged £2,465 with their first prize pedigree cow the second calver Clayden Mendel Wendy at £2,600, and another second calver at £2,680.

In-calf Heifers sold to £1,880. Bulling Heifers to £900. Maiden Heifers to £620. British Blue Bull (28 months) £3,000. Limousin Bull (24 months) £2,400.

Top 10 Fresh Heifers £2,670. Top 5 Fresh Cows £2,532. 66 Fresh Heifers (all breeds and faults) £2,041. 18 Fresh Cows (all breeds and faults) £2,068.
